

Mentor for a Day Program - Mentors

HOW TO SIGN UP AS A MENTOR

When registering for the Emerging Issues Cleantech conference, select "Are you interested in participating in our Mentor for a Day program as a mentor?" and enter your field of work. You will be paired ahead of the conference with a student studying in your field who would like to be mentored. Your email address will be shared with your mentee so the two of you can connect ahead of the conference.

AHEAD OF THE CONFERENCE

We recommend scheduling a time and place to meet your mentee for the day of the conference so when you arrive you'll be able to find each other easily.

AT THE CONFERENCE

Meet your mentee at the place previously determined by you and your mentee. If you have difficulty locating each other, there will be MEIA staff and Student Chapter volunteers to help link you up. Visit the Student Chapter booth if you have any questions.

WHAT TO EXPECT

It is not necessary to spend the whole day together, but you are encouraged to sit with your mentee for breakfast and/or lunch. Introduce them to people at the table and other people you know at the conference. Encourage their participation in the conversation by asking for their opinion on a topic being discussed or asking a question about themselves. If there is more to talk about then the day allows, you can set up a coffee meet up following the conference.
